- Big profile and spacious footprint

**The Beast Riders**



- Small, low-profile bucket seat
- Leather harness included
- Requires a sissy bar for mounting
- Seated is less comfortable for long rides
- Build time is 18-20 weeks

**Rowdy Hound**



- Quick-release system
- Made from advanced materials
- Traps heat and restricts airflow
- Open hatch places hard impact edges at dog's head and neck
- Mounts to limited range of motorcycles
- Travel kennel requires acclimation

**Pillion Pooch**



- Superior protection from the elements
- Accommodates one dog up to 30kg or two small dogs
- Large profile with colorful tent-like appearance
- Requires luggage rack for mounting
- Places full load behind passenger seat
- Available off-the-shelf; only need to drill screw holes

**K9 Moto Cockpit**



- Comfortable position for long rides
- Low, sleek profile and center of gravity
- Custom-built through remote process
- Accommodates most aftermarket accessories
- Variety of vinyl and stitching options
- Distributes load for natural ride dynamic
- Positions dog close for shared riding experience
- Fits dogs weighing 20lb- 120lb
- Build time is 6-8 weeks

**Sidecar**



- Difficult to mount and alters ride dynamic
